Overnight Stays – Ground Rules

Overnight stays at the club in campervans, caravans or tents with their own cooking facilities will be permitted, however the following ground rules must be observed:

Anyone who is unwell with any new symptoms, however minor, which may be Covid-19, must avoid attending the club. In this situation they must follow government guidance and stay at home for 7 days and then only leave if their temperature has returned to normal.

Anyone who has had contact with people, family or household members who are displaying symptoms of Covid-19 must avoid attending the club for a minimum of 14 days.

Members who have visited the club and accessed the compound and/or club house are asked to inform the club if they subsequently show any signs or symptoms of Covid-19. In such cases please advise by email to: memsec@kielderwatersc.org. The anonymity of any individuals reporting a suspected case will be maintained.

- Overnight stays at the club is possible for members only.
- Please do not arrange social gatherings (large groups) or invite friends / visitors.
- When attending the club please ensure to follow UK Government guidelines for social distancing.
- Members must remain conservative and considerate in their actions both around the club and when travelling to and from the club.
- It is suggested that members bring with them essential items, for example food & drink, hand sanitiser, cleaning products, etc. Please be considerate of local communities.
- All rubbish must be taken home.
- When positioning your tent, campervan or caravan please ensure to leave at least 2 metres distance to ensure social distancing can be maintained along the routes to and from and accessing your tent, campervan, or caravan.
- Members must update the booking system advising the days they will use the club and colour code if they intend to stay over (instructions can be found in the booking form)
- Ensure to read and be familiar with the club risk assessment for overnight stays
- Have fun and enjoy!!

Update: From 01-August-20, there will be limited access to the club house, for use of the disabled toilet only. Please be aware:

- The route to and from the toilet is marked with barrier tape, please ensure to stay inside this area.
- When accessing the club house ensure to sanitise your hands before and after touching door handles (hand gel is available within the club house).
- When using the toilet ensure to clean it before and after use with the provided disinfectant spray.
- Do not use or access any of the rooms within the clubhouse. This is because we cannot currently make this area Covid secure.
- You must not use either of the galleys or changing rooms.
- Do not congregate in the clubhouse.
- Do not use the club house for getting changed.
- Do not use the shower in the disabled toilet (apart from not being Covid secure, this shower leaks into the clubhouse and has no hot water)
- If these rules are not adhered to; the clubhouse will be closed.
